- 3. Condition. Most buyers these days are looking for movein ready homes. There are many ways to create this look.
 First, a fresh coat of paint, new carpet or recently
 treated hardwoods will go a long way toward encouraging
 buyers to make an offer. New paint and floors are one
 less thing they will have to worry about as they face
 the overwhelming task of moving into a new home. With
