- * Photos with date stamps, caption text or watermarks will not be considered.
- * Submissions must be made by individuals who are at least 18 years of age. Youth who would like to participate should have a parent or guardian submit entries on their behalf.

* You do not need to reside in the Town of Parker limits to participate.
